IMMUNIZATION POLICY

IMMUNIZATIONS

The Carden School of Fresno will use the following procedures to ensure that all students present evidence of having been immunized against the following diseases: varicella (chickenpox), diphtheria, pertussis (Whooping cough), poliomyelitis, measles, rubella, mumps, tetanus, and hepatitis B. Prior to enrollment, the parent or guardian must present a completed Certificate of Immunization Status (CIS) form to the school. The Director or designee will review the information and file the signed CIS form in the cumulative file. The Director will review the immunization deficiencies and provide written notice to the parents or guardians informing them of:

- 1. Minimum immunization requirements
- 2. Denial of further attendance by the student

Following proper notification, the school shall exclude the student for noncompliance with the immunization requirements. Students transferring from another school will be expected to present proof of immunization compliance prior to school attendance. The parent may ask the previous school to send this information directly to the school.
